

Pig Out Dice Game

Keep rolling to accumulate points, but roll a 1 and you "pig out!"

Setup:

- 2 dice
- Some paper and pencils for keeping score

Number of players:

Small groups of 2–6 players

The object:

Be the first player to score 100 points or more.

How to play:

Players take turns rolling the two dice and following these rules:

1. On a turn, a player can roll the dice as many times as they want, keeping a running total of the sums that come up. When the player decides to stop rolling, they record the total and add it to the scores from previous rounds.
2. However, if a 1 comes up on one of the dice before the player decides to stop rolling, the player scores 0 for that round, and it's the next player's turn.
3. Even worse, if a 1 comes up on both dice, not only does the turn end, but the player's entire accumulated total returns to 0. (Pig out!)
4. The first person to reach 100 points (or a lesser number if you prefer) is the winner.
